- **DCS Hotline** (1-888-767-2445)
This is the confidential state-wide hotline to report abuse and/or neglect about a specific child. The caller must provide the child's full name, DOB, residential address and the name and location of the school the child is attending.
 - The Hotline cannot confirm nor deny if there is an open case.
 - The caller can request a call back from a DCS official. The caller must provide contact information.
 - To provide information on a specific case, the information will be entered as a status communication to the case worker.
